

Sick Child Policy

If a child has suffered from vomiting or diarrhoea we ask that you allow 48 hours recovery time before returning to Pre-school. In the case of an infectious disease the child should not return until he/she is no longer infectious. A list of Notifiable Diseases is attached to this policy.

The Pre School notifies Ofsted of any food poisoning affecting 2 or more children looked after on the premises, any child having meningitis or the outbreak on the premises of any 'notifiable disease'.

If a child becomes ill in Pre-school, the first aider or Supervisor will care for the child and you will be contacted as soon as possible, and asked to collect your child early, if necessary. If we are unable to contact you, the Supervisor will endeavour to reach someone on the Emergency Contact List, who will previously be authorised to collect the child by way of the registration form.

In the rare situation that the Pre-school has to seek Emergency Treatment for a child we will:

When we are advised that a child has attended Pre-school with an infectious condition we will advise other parents by posting a notice on the glass dividing doors just inside the Memorial Hall and at the entrance door at Jocks Lane.
